Subject: Amendments in Revised New Empanelment Policy.

In continuation of the Revised New Empanelment Policy dated 08-06-2017, the following additions /amendments are made in the clauses therein:

A. New Private Hospitals:-

i.a. Hospitals already having at least Entry level NABH certificate will also be considered for Empanelment. However, these hospitals will have to get full NABH accreditation within one year of empanelment failing which these hospitals will automatically stand de-empanelled without giving any prior notice. On submission of full NABH accreditation certificates the hospital will continue to be empanelled for two years more subject to the validity of accreditation certificate. Thereafter, the hospital applies afresh.

v. Consent:

a.i Consent (Annexure-II) for providing medical facility on 152 package rates and implants and 2 non-packages rates shall be given by Entry level NABH hospitals on Non NABH Rates on the prescribed format as per the guidelines issued by the State Govt. vide letter dated 21.05.2015 regarding the package rates/implant and amended from time to time. The hospital will not charge more than the rates prescribed for these package/implants rates as per the instructions issued by the State Govt. vide letter dated 21.05.2015 and amended time to time.

vi Rate of Reimbursement:

vi.a Package Rates:-

Reimbursement on 152 package rates and implants and 2 non-package rates shall be allowed to New Empanelled Entry Level NABH Accredited Private Hospitals on Non NABH rates as per instructions dated 21.05.2015 and amended time to time.

Non-Package Rates:-

The reimbursement on the expenditure incurred on the treatment taken from the New Empanelled Entry Level NABH Accredited Private Hospitals shall be allowed at PGI, Chandigarh rates+75% of the balance amount on the non package procedures.

ix Existing 56 Empanelled Private Hospitals:

a.i The existing Non-NABH Empanelled private hospitals shall continue for a period for two years i.e. from 08-06-2017 to 07-06-2019 to get full NABH Accreditation failing which

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these hospitals will automatically stands de-empanelled if they are not able to provide full NABH Accreditation.

- b.i On submission of full NABH Accreditation certificate by existing non NABH hospitals (**as mentioned at ix.a.i above**) the hospital will continue for **one year more** subject to the validity of accreditation certificate thus making a total of three years. Thereafter, the hospital applies afresh.

C. **Private Medical Colleges** in the State of Haryana which are recognised by Medical Council of India (MCI) shall be empanelled for Haryana Govt. at Non NABH package rates. However, the application form (Annexure-I) notified on 08.06.2017 and consent form (Annexure-II, for Entry Level NABH Accredited Private Hospital) shall remain the same. The reimbursement on the expenditure incurred on the treatment taken from the Private Medical Colleges which are recognised by Medical Council of India (MCI) shall be allowed at PGI, Chandigarh rates+75% of the balance amount on the non package procedures.
