The Governor of Haryana is pleased to accord sanction to fill up the 662 post of Medical Officers (HCMS Group-A) in Health Department, Haryana, through Departmental High Power Selection Committee on regular basis.

Members of Departmental High Power Selection Committee/Interview Board as notified vide notification No. 25/6/2004-6HB-I, dated 26.6.2015 are as follow, which will follow the selection criteria as mentioned at Sr. No.4 :-

**Note:-** If one Director is on leave/away on official duty, he may be substituted by the other Director and the quorum of interviewing Board shall be that of simple majority. These two Boards shall submit their results to the Chairperson of Departmental High Power Selection Committee for the compilation and preparation of final recommendation to the Government.

4. **Criteria for selection:-**

Total Marks (max 140)	The total selection shall be made out of 140 marks
MBBS Score (max 100)	Maximum 100 marks shall be allotted to the score of candidate in his/her MBBS degree e.g. one who scores 60% in MBBS degree will be given a weightage of 60 marks out of 100.
Experience of professional work and service in Rural Area (max 10)	Maximum 10 marks shall be allotted @ 2 marks per year for experience in Govt. rural sector, not in private sector but those who have experience in other than rural shall be allotted @ 1 mark per year; subject to maximum 10 marks including both rural and other than rural.  The experience from the State Health Department Haryana, NHM in Haryana, PGIMS Rohtak, Govt. Medical College of the State and Agroha Medical Institute which is a Govt. aided Medical Education Institution only will be considered. This would include contractual and adhoc appointments also.

Post Graduation Qualification (max 14)	Maximum 14 marks will be allotted to the Post Graduation qualification @ 14 marks to a PG Degree holder and 10 marks to a Diploma holder (since tenure of Diploma is 2/3 <sup>rd</sup> of the Degree).
Interview (max 16)	Maximum 16 marks will be allotted for the interview of the candidate; out of this, 12 marks will be given to the professional knowledge and 4 marks will be given to the aptitude and general awareness of the candidate.

**5. Calling of applications, forms, fee etc:-**

Application from the eligible candidates may be invited through the national dailies of Hindi and English. The application form alongwith instructions can be downloaded from official website of Health Department ([www.haryanahealth.nic.in](http://www.haryanahealth.nic.in)) free of cost and applications can be submitted by hand or through registered post on or before the closing date in the office of DGHS, Haryana, Sector-6, Panchkula. Fee for general category candidates will be Rs. 500/- and Rs. 250/- for BC, SC and Women Candidates and they may be asked to visit the official website of the Department for interview schedule and other updates. Specialists are given preference in the selection as per approved criteria.

**6. Other conditions which needs to be brought in the notice of candidates at the time of advertisement :-**

- (i) Vacancies may decrease or increase as per availability.
- (ii) Reservation upto 2% for Freedom Fighter and their children/grand children will be available only if quota reserved for Ex-servicemen or Backward Classes remains unfilled to that extent due to non availability of suitable Ex-servicemen or their dependents or non-availability of suitable candidates from Backward Classes. Over all reservation either from the unfilled vacancies of Ex-servicemen or from the Backward Classes for Freedom Fighters/their children/grand children will remain limited to 2% only.
- (iii) Reservation benefit will be admissible to the bonafide residents of Haryana State only. The 'Resident Certificate of Haryana' and the 'Certificate of SC/BC/ESM/DESM/PH of Haryana' issued by the competent authority under the latest Govt., instructions will only be accepted.
- (iv) Preference will be given to the candidates having PG Degree/Diploma and Rural Service in Haryana State (Health Department/NHM/PGIMS, Rohtak/State Government Medical Colleges or State aided Medical College like Agroha).
- (v) A waiting list equal of 50% of total advertised posts will e prepared which will remain valid for a period of 6 (six) months from the date of issue of first appointment letter.
- (vi) Once appointed they may be posted in rural areas for two years initially.

(viii) No candidate will apply if he/she does not have the MBBS Degree, internship completion certificate, permanent registration or if the result is awaited. All incomplete applications will be rejected.

**Note:-** It may be ensured to carry out the selection process as per latest instructions/Guidelines issued by the Chief Secretary to Government Haryana, regarding Reservation/age etc.
