

National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS)
&
National Programme for the Health care of the Elderly (NPHCE)

Introduction:

For prevention and Control of Non Communicable Diseases (NCD) GOI, MoH&FW has launched National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS) & National Programme for the Health care of the Elderly (NPHCE) in 2010-12 across 100 district of the Country. It is an independent programme with 80:20 centre: state share. These two programmes are integrated at various levels for optimum utilization of resources & will be managed/supervised by State NCD cell at State Head Quarter (SHQ) & district NCD cell at District Head Quarter. State NCD cell is established in the O/o DGHS, Sec-6, Panchkula.

In Haryana, programme is implemented in distt. Mewat, Ambala, Kurukshetra and Yamuna Nagar - being implemented in 4 District Hospitals, 17 Community Health Centres (CHCs), 52 Primary Health Centres (PHCs) & 406 Sub Centers (SC) of the above said districts. The target population covered under the programme is given in the table below:

Initiatives undertaken are as follows:

- Under NPCDCS –Initiative was taken to screen above 30 year population for Diabetes (DM) & Hypertension (HT) in the selected distt. 695300 persons above 30 year are screened till 4.2.2013. Out of them 32126 (4.6%) & 46699 (6.7%) persons are found suspected for DM & HT.
- Screening services for most common cancers have been initiated at DH level.
- NCD cum Geriatric clinic, Cardiac care unit (CCU), District cancer care facility (DCCF) & Geriatric Ward are being setup in above said District hospitals.
- Under DCCF, Chemotherapy is being given to - 3 pts in Mewat, 47 pts in Kurukshetra & 5 pts in Yamuna Nagar.
- Funds have been transferred to PGIMS, Rohtak for providing free chemotherapy to cancer patients under the cancer component of the programme.
- Physiotherapy units are being strengthened with human resource & equipments in these districts & are under establishment process in CHCs.
- Under NPHCE, aids & appliances are distributed to the elderly in distt. Kurukshetra & Mewat.
