

Guidelines for Best Village Award Scheme under PC & PNDD for F.Y 2015- 16

Approved in 11th State Supervisory Board Meeting held on 16-07-2015

Best Village Award Scheme under PNDD was started in 2009 and implemented in 2010-11 for awarding the best village with the highest sex ratio at birth in every district. The amended criteria for Best Village Award Scheme are as under:-

- Since, Haryana has villages with range of population from 500 to 10,000 only villages with population of 5000 and above will be considered.
- Period will be from January, 2015 to December, 2015.
- The villages in each district will be selected from cumulative ANM Birth Registration data collected from January, 2015 to December, 2015 (ANM data reflects the actual sex ratio of village at birth as compared to CRS data which reflects data of place of birth).
- The villages selected should have more than 30 deliveries during this period.
- The Award money of Rs. 1.50 lac will be given to one village in each district with highest sex ratio during the year 2015. The money will be utilized for Girl Empowerment in the villages in the form of scholarships to the 3 meritorious girls in 10th standard (passed in previous year i.e. 2015). The money will be deposited by the Civil Surgeon in the joint account of meritorious girl & her mother (if mother not alive then father) in the ratio of 50% to the topper, 30% to the second & 20% to the 3rd meritorious girl. If the two girls have same merit then the award money will be distributed equally between them.

The Appraisal certificate will be given to all the concerned officers of the best village of the district like MO In charge of PHC/ANM/ASHA and Anganwari worker by Deputy Commissioner including Village Gram Panchayat members.

- The utilization of award money will be sent by Civil Surgeon in the form of names, address & account details of the girls to the State Head Quarter with their contact details before 31st March, 2016.
- State Award of Rs.5 Lac and appraisal certificate will be given to the Gram Panchayat along with MO In charge of PHC/ANM/ASHA and Anganwari worker of the village with the highest sex ratio in the entire State during this period. This money to be utilized for construction of room in school (preferred in Girl School) by 31st March 2016 and utilization certificate to be verified by the concerned Civil Surgeon of the district.
