

## **User manual for using Mobile application for TB notification**

**Intended users:** Health facilities doing notification of TB patients to nodal officers

### **Pre-requisite:**

1. Android phone with OS 2.3.3 or above.
2. GPRS / mobile internet / Wi-Fi with internet connectivity for the mobile of use
3. Registration of Health facility in Nikshay alongwith mobile number

### **Instructions for field staff and officials:**

1. Ensure that the health facility is registered in Nikshay with mobile number
2. Maintain file at DTC with hard copy of each health facility registration form duly signed alongwith the HFID number
3. Share the HFID number with respective person notifying the cases
4. Share the apk file with the health facility (soft copy) (it can be shared via email or blue tooth transfer as suitable locally)
5. This file should be downloaded on the android mobile by private health facility.
6. Shutdown and restart mobile after running the application after running the application. Subsequently, notification can be done.
7. The login ID is 6 digit HFID no <#####> and the password is 10 digit mobile no <#####>(which is registered in Nikshay)
8. GPRS / mobile internet / Wi-Fi with internet connectivity should be active for sending online data
9. On successful notification a screenshot appears showing the patient registration number
10. In case connectivity is not ensured, data is stored locally and will be uploaded on connection.
11. The notified patient details will be merged with server data every day at 20:00 hrs and can be seen in Nikshay database of the local TU / District on next working day

### **Instructions for users (health facilities doing the notification)**

1. Ensure that your health facility is registered in Nikshay with mobile number
2. Maintain a hard copy of registration form duly signed alongwith the HFID number
3. Seek apk file from concerned DTO of the district via email or blue tooth transfer as suitable locally (or download from <http://www.nikshay.gov.in> <http://apps.mgov.gov.in> in future)
4. This file should be downloaded on the android mobile (2.3.3. or above) from which the notification is intended to be done.
5. Ensure that GPRS / mobile internet / Wi-Fi with internet connectivity is on
6. Shutdown and restart mobile after running the application after running the application.
7. Then subsequently, notification can be done.
8. The login ID is 6 digit HFID no <#####> and the password is 10 digit mobile no <#####>(which is registered in Nikshay)
9. GPRS / mobile internet / Wi-Fi with internet connectivity should be active for sending online data

10. On successful notification a screenshot appears showing the patient registration number
11. In case connectivity is not ensured, data is stored locally and will be uploaded on connection.
12. The notified patient details will be merged with server data every day at 20:00 hrs and can be seen in Nikshay database of the local TU / District on next working day
